You will be notified of specific dates and times of participation as soon as the programmes are sent out. The SADI Gala evening is compulsory for all students (Dates to be confirmed).

Competition/Festival rules (I trust that the following rules will be adhered to by all participants and family members)

1. Students must arrive **2 hours** before estimated dance time.
2. All students must have the correct clothing for their specific items with them.
3. All hair must be neat and tidy for dance items. All Fringes must be pinned back, no loose pieces of hair please. Hair styles for groups will be arranged beforehand.
4. Please make sure that all students arrive with base, blusher, eyeliner, and mascara already applied. All other make-up will be applied by the teacher or assistants in order for all members of the group to look the same.
5. No Jewellery or visible piercings are allowed on stage. Please remove or cover these up at home to prevent loss of these items.
6. No Nail polish is allowed. Please remove this at home.
7. **Very Important!! Remember!**
All students taking part in a solo, duet, trio, quartet, or character is responsible for his/her own music. **All students must burn each song separately on 2 cd's** (1 as a backup).
8. No laughing or talking in the hall while there are dancers on stage.
9. Please consciously treat other studio's teachers and students with respect. Treat them like you would like to be treated!
10. **Very Important!!** All students must stay until the end of a section, in order to receive their results and prizes. All uncollected prizes will be forfeited.
11. **Clothing for Studio solo's, solo's, and d/t/q's**
Students taking part in any of these items may wear any tasteful and colourful dance attire of their own choice as long as they are not character costumes. It may sparkle! All costumes must be approved by the teacher before the dress rehearsal so that they can be worn during the dress rehearsal.
12. **Clothing for groups**
Each group has specific clothing. Letters regarding this information have already been given out in class.
13. Please will all students make sure that the following items are brought with to each participation.
 - Complete dance attire for each item
 - Accessories: tap shoes, dance paws, hip hop sneakers, jazz sneakers, socks, props, etc.
 - Hair: gel (La pebras), hair spray, hair pins/clips, brush, comb
 - Mini sewing kit: needle, thread, extra buttons, scissors, pins, safety pins, etc.
 - Make-up: base, face powder (translucent powder) mascara, eyeliner, blusher, fake eyelashes (Seniors & Adults), face cream, make-up remover (wipes are the easiest), glitter.
 - Extra: towel, water, food, face cloth, cotton wool, ear buds
14. **Cameras and Video Camera's**
No photography of any sort is permitted in the hall! You may take photos in the dressing area or lobby.
15. **Studio t-shirt**
The studio t-shirt is compulsory for all students taking part in competitions or festival work and must be worn when not wearing your festival clothing. If you have not yet ordered a t-shirt please contact us as soon as possible with your order.
16. No spectators are allowed to watch the **SATCH** competition as it is a closed audition with participants and judges only.
